






Teachers' Day Celebration

promoting awareness for education in our country. Our Vice -Principal explained the true meaning of 'GURU', with that the students organized varied fun games for their teachers and honored them with the token of



compassion and humanitarian spirit. We have a multi-culture student population;hence we


teach children the importance of tolerance and respecting culture. discipline, value and integrity are the foundations of our school.
