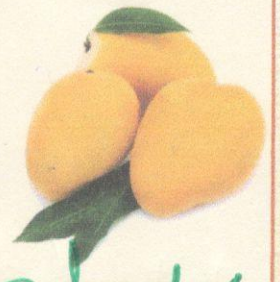

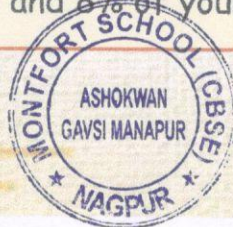
National Fruit - Mango (*Mangifera indica*)

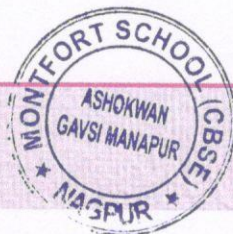

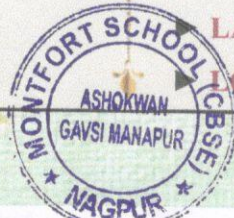
