- ◆ It was **instituted in 1954** by the Government of India.
- ◆ The award is given for **exceptional service or performance** in any field of human endeavour — including **art, literature, science, public service, and sports**.
- ◆ It is **conferred by the President of India**.
- ◆ The Bharat Ratna represents the **nation's highest respect and gratitude** for outstanding contribution to the country.
- ◆ The medallion features the **Sun and the words "Bharat Ratna" in Devanagari script** on the front, and the **State Emblem of India** and motto on the reverse.
- ◆ It is considered a **symbol of India's recognition of extraordinary talent, dedication, and service to the nation**.
